TOOLS TO USE

- Safety Glasses/Goggles
- Gloves
- White Cotton Wiping Cloths
- Wet Floor Signs
- Carpet Scraper
If needed
- Bottle & Sprayer
If mixing a concentrate as a spot remover
- Vacuum
- Spotter Brush
- Pump-Up Sprayer
- Measuring Cup
If not using dilution control
- Mop Bucket & Wringer
- Walk-Off Mats or Rags
To absorb moisture
- Air Mover/Carpet Fan/Floor Fan(s)
Optional
- Carpet Spin Bonnets
- 175–300 RPM Floor Machine with Pad Driver



CHEMICALS TO USE

- Gum Remover
If needed
- Carpet Spot Remover(s)
- Spin Bonnet Cleaner
- Neutralizer/Conditioner

- Safety Glasses/Goggles
- Gloves

- Wet Floor Signs

If needed
- Bottle & Sprayer
If mixing a concentrate as a spot remover
- Vacuum

- Carpet Spot Remover(s)

Restorative Carpet Cleaning



TOOLS TO USE

- Safety Glasses/Goggles
- Gloves

If needed
- Bottle & Sprayer
If mixing a concentrate as a spot remover
- Vacuum
- Spotter Brush
- Pump-Up Sprayer
- Measuring Cup
If not using dilution control
- Air Mover/Carpet Fan/Floor Fan(s)
Optional



CHEMICALS TO USE

- Gum Remover
If needed
- Carpet Spot Remover(s)
- Extraction Cleaner
- Defoamer
- Pre-Spray/Pretreatment
Should be compatible with Extraction Cleaner
- Post-treatment
Optional
